

Plug the adaptor into a standard household outlet, you will see 12:08 AM on the display and the clock is

- If the display is "blank" after plugging in, please check whether the DIMMER on the back is at the HIGH position.
- To backup the time and alarm settings in case of power outage, we strongly recommend you to install three AAA alkaline batteries(Not Included) on the bottom of the clock
- 1.Press "TIME SET" button to enter time setting.
- the HOUR and MINUTE digits will flash on the display.

t means the alarm is on: If the alarm icon disappears.

t means completely turn off the alarm and it will not go off

2.Press "TIME SET" button again to confirm and exit from Time Setting mode.

• The clock will exit automatically from the Time Setup mode if no action is taken within 10 seconds. (Action refers to pressing the desired button for setup)

SWITCH TIME FORMAT (12/24HR)

Press " o toggle between 12 and 24 hour mode (the default is 12-hour time format).

 When using the 12-hour time format, AM/PM icon will appear to suggest morning/afternoon time.

ALARM SETTING

1.Press "ALARM SET" button to enter alarm time setting,

Press " () " to advance to the correct hour, and press

" to advance to the correct minute

the HOUR and MINUTE digits will flash on the display.

(hold for rapid setting)



2.Press "ALARM SET" button again to confirm and exit from Alarm Setting mode.

NOTICE:

- The clock will exit automatically from the Alarm Setup mode if no action is taken within 10 seconds. (Action refers to pressing the desired button for setup)
- The default alarm volume is maximum (90dB). Slide the **VOLUME** knob at the back of the clock to adjust volume with a range of 30-90dB.

To View the Alarm Time:

In normal time mode, press and hold "ALARM SET" button

ALARM SOUND SETTING

1. Press ALARM SOUND

The alarm sound options will flash, and the alarm sound will ring. Press ALARM SOUND repeatedly to choose among five different alarm sound options: 01 = Siren : 02 = Beep: 03 = Birds Chirping; 04 =Buzzer; 05 = Soft Music.

2. If the alarm sound option, for example "02", flashes for more than 5 seconds, the alarm sound "02" will be confirmed automatically and exit from Alarm Sound Set Mode.

- Press any button on the back except ALARM SOUND to confirm your alarm sound quickly.
- If you are a heavy sleeper, it is recommended that you prefer "01" (Siren) as your wake up sound.

SNOOZE /TURN OFF ALARM DAILY

1. When the alarm goes off, press SNOOZE button to snooze for a while, the alarm will go off again 9 minutes

2.To cancel the snooze at any time or to TURN OFF this day alarm while it is sounding, press any of the five buttons on the back of the clock. The alarm will go off again at the

same time the next day. 3.If not stop the alarm, it will last 8mins before going silent.

BRIGHTNESS SETTING

- Slide the DIMMER knob at the back of the clock to adjust the display brightness.
- (It can be adjusted from 0 to 100%)

BATTERY OPEARTED SETTING

Install 3* AAA alkaline batteries(Not Included) into Battery Compartment.

NOTICE: Under the battery power, clock has all functions except for USB charging your electronic device.

USB CHARGING PORT

 Connect a USB charging cable to charge your cellphone or other smart device.
